Selection process

INASL will set up a 3-member committee to consider the applications. Names of selected candidates will be announced on the INASL Website by 15th July of the year.

Preference will be given to candidates who:

- 1. Have published (or accepted for publication) papers.
- 2. Are senior in training (e.g. 3rd year trainees over 2nd year, etc).

Published papers will get more weightage than seniority; age is not a preference criterion.

Support provided

- INASL will provide to & fro economy airfare (maximum Rs 15,000) from the candidate's town/city to host centre.
- 2. The training center will make lodging arrangements for the candidate.
- 3. The selected candidates will bear the costs of food and local travel.
